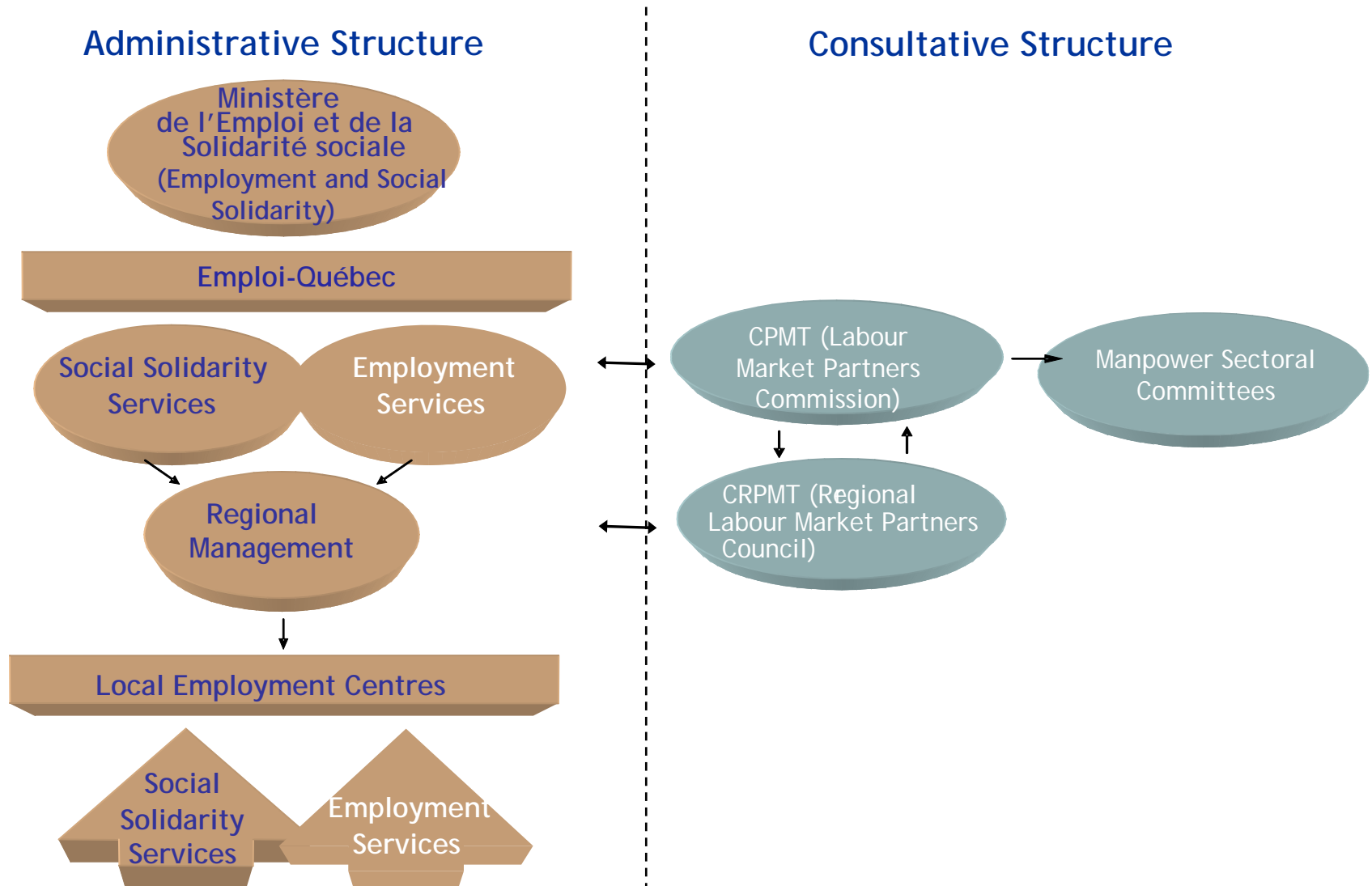

Emploi-Québec's Consultative Structure

The Act respecting the *ministère de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale* and establishing the *commission des partenaires du marché du travail* endowed Emploi-Québec with a **consultative structure**, unique in its kind, which includes:

- ❖ The *Commission des partenaires du marché du travail* (Labour Market Partners Commission);
- ❖ 17 *conseils régionaux des partenaires du marché du travail* (Regional Labour Market Partners Councils).

Each of the bodies is composed of:

- ❖ Six **business** representatives;
- ❖ Six **workforce** representatives;
- ❖ Four **education network** representatives;
- ❖ Two **community** representatives.

Consultative Structure

Commission des partenaires du marché du travail

- ❖ Participates in defining labour market **objectives and strategies**;
- ❖ **Advises the Minister** on the general orientation of the labour market policy;
- ❖ Signs an **agreement regarding Emploi-Québec management** with the Minister responsible for Employment;
- ❖ Adopts **Emploi-Québec's action plan** and local and regional action plans;
- ❖ Exercises **regulation-making powers** regarding certain files, including the *Act to foster the development of manpower training* and the *Act respecting manpower vocational training and qualification*;
- ❖ Facilitates **concerted efforts** and various actions undertaken by the partners.

Consultative Structure

Conseil régional des partenaires du marché du travail

- ❖ Defines the **problem areas** of the regional labour market;
- ❖ Participates in the development of **Emploi-Québec's regional action plan** and submits it to the *CPMT (Labour Market Partners Commission)*;
- ❖ **Adapts** workforce-related measures, programs and funds to the **regional realities**;
- ❖ Establishes workforce and employment **intervention priorities** and **regional objectives**;
- ❖ Proposes criteria for the **distribution of resources**.

Realisations of a *Conseil régional des partenaires* (Regional Partners Council):

FNFM regional fund for labour force training, ratification of specific agreements, regional consultations, studies, modulation of measures, etc.

Mission

Contribute to manpower and employment development and work to counteract unemployment, exclusion and poverty within a perspective of economic and social development.

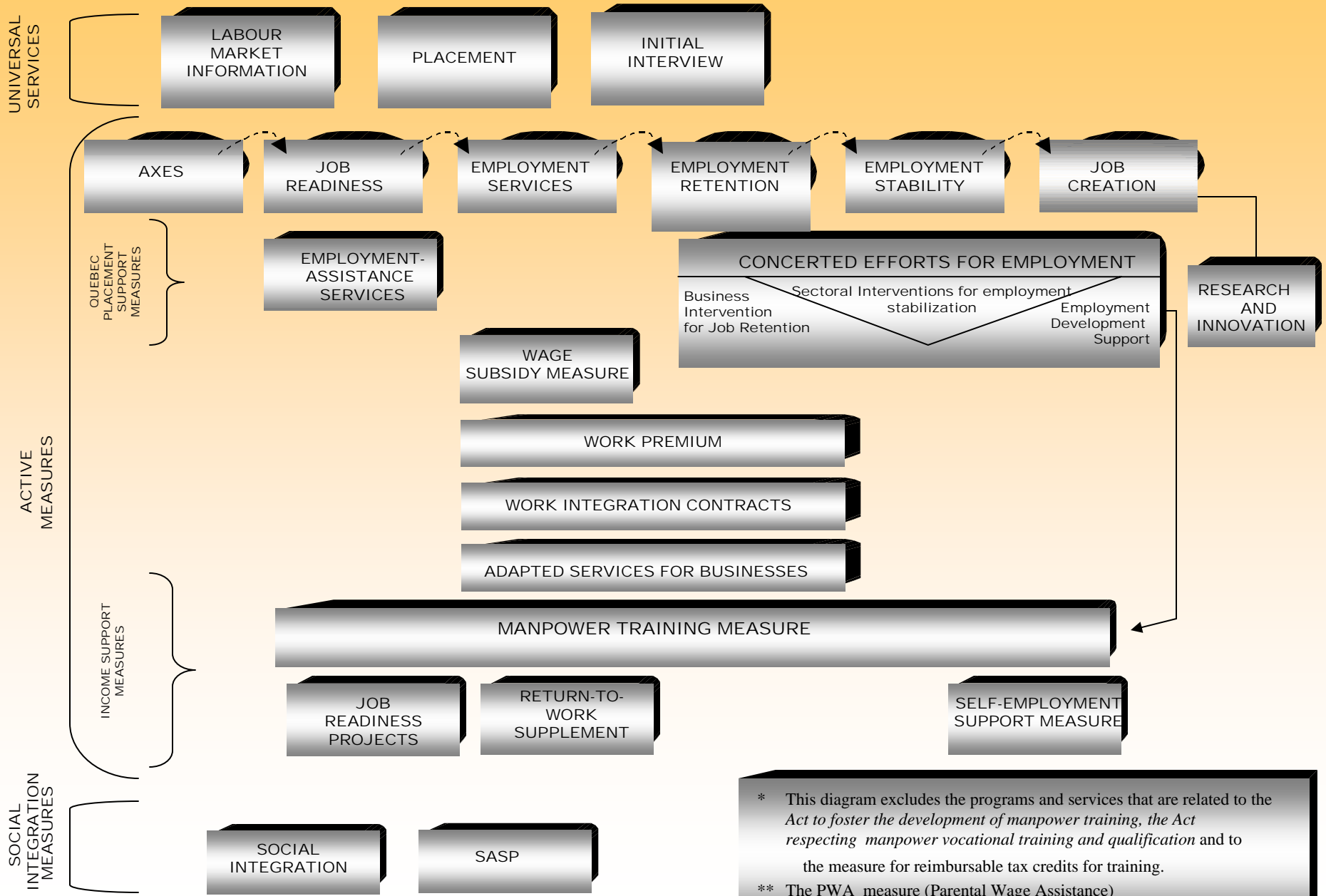
Emploi-Québec is responsible for administering Quebec's income security plan.

- ❖ Assign financial assistance to persons and families who cannot provide for their needs on their own.
- ❖ Provide assistance and coaching to *last-resort financial assistance* adult recipients who are not ready to undertake an employment integration process.

Public Employment Services

- ❖ Foster labour market and employment participation of the highest number of Quebecers possible.
- ❖ Contribute to the productivity improvement and the adaptation capacity of businesses especially in regards to demographic and commercial changes.
